5. Describe your plans and intentions for bringing the invention to such point of practical application including, if further development of the invention is necessary to make a salable or licensable thing or process, a description of such development and the facilities and personnel available for that purpose.
6. Describe the nature and extent of rights desired.
7. If you believe that rights greater than free public use are needed to bring the invention into use, give the reasons for such belief and the probable duration of such need.
8. List the countries in which you would be interested in filing applications for patents.
9. If publication of the substance of this invention has occurred or is contemplated, please state the name of the journal and date of publication.
